TRC Environmental Corp. (TRC) prepared an Emergency Response Plan (ERP) for the proposed Cornerstone Solar Project in Jefferson Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania, dated September of 2025. The results of the ERP demonstrated that the project will comply with the provisions outlined in Jefferson Township's Solar Energy Systems Ordinance. Specifically, the construction of the project will install emergency features, furnish/implement required safety training, furnish specialized firefighting equipment, and execute communication protocols.

TRC understands that the project site plan has been revised to remove two small parcels on the far west side of the project, which included the removal of 7,968 solar panels. The site plan revision also involves moving the project substation approximately 150 feet to the east.

During construction, the emergency access routes on state routes and township roads, site access with installation of four new driveways, installation of emergency features, safety training, communication, and the expected construction activities will not change as a result of the site plan revision. Therefore, the details and data included in the September 2025 ERP remain unchanged.

During operation, the emergency access routes on state routes and township roads, site access using four newly installed driveways, use of installed emergency features, safety training and communication will not change as a result of the site plan revision. Therefore, the details and data included in the September 2025 ERP remain unchanged.

Based on my review of the revised site plan, the removal of solar panels/equipment from the two parcels will not require any changes to the ERP.
